### JVK Organizes Counselling Session on Positive Discipline for KG Educators

In its continuous pursuit of nurturing not just students but also the educators who shape young minds, JVK School organized a specialized counselling session on Positive Discipline for its Kindergarten teachers. The session took place on campus and was chaired by the highly respected and experienced counsellor, Mrs. Anila, known for her deep expertise in early childhood behavior and educator support.

### The Theme: Positive Discipline – A Foundation for Lifelong Learning

The session centered around the theme of Positive Discipline, an approach that emphasizes guidance, mutual respect, empathy, and emotional safety—especially essential in early childhood settings. #### Insights from Mrs. Anila: A Guiding Light for Educators

- Connection before correction – Building a



- trusting relationship before addressing behaviors.

- Encouragement over praise – Focusing on effort and progress rather than outcomes.

Through real-life examples, interactive discussions, and scenario-based exercises, Mrs. Anila engaged the teachers in reflective practices and guided them on how to respond to common classroom challenges such as tantrums, non-cooperation, attention-seeking behaviors, and peer conflicts.

The session was not just theoretical—it provided hands-on strategies for creating a respectful and emotionally safe classroom environment. Teachers learned how to:

- Use positive language and calm tones when correcting behavior.
- Encourage problem-solving and conflict resolution among children.

- Reinforce positive behavior through affirmation, empathy, and consistent responses.

Mrs. Anila also emphasized the importance of self-care for educators, acknowledging the

emotional demands of teaching young children and offering ways to manage stress and maintain professional joy and balance.

The session was described by participants as eye-opening and deeply meaningful. Teachers expressed how the insights shared would transform the way they engage with their students—shifting from a control-based approach to one that nurtures inner discipline, cooperation, and mutual respect.
