Celebrations offer intermittent relief from restricted environment

The social environment of infants, toddlers and preschool children is limited to family, day care centers, neighborhood and institutes of parents' choice. All of which have a rushed schedule and formal mode of interaction that impoverish children's experiences.

Play is children's favorite way of learning

Playful activities bring out natural expressions. A Greek philosopher of 428 BC, Plato noted; "you can discover more about a person in an hour of play than in a year of conversation". Children use the virtues of play the most. Through play they discover their environment, build communicative abilities, master cognitive skills and enhance social development to meet the ever rising challenges of childhood.

Free from authoritative control, play is firmly integrated in all festival celebrations; may it be Halloween, Holi, Christmas, Diwali or birthday parties. Children then reveal their unvoiced thoughts. They explore their experiences without the fear of being judged. Self-guided reliving of the unpleasant experiences helps resolve the conflicts and heals the injured emotional health.

They learn to deal with joy that is mingled with challenges and imperfections. They overcome stage phobia and develop self-confidence besides learning to regulate their emotions.

Induces administrative capabilities

Working in team and putting up stage performance also involves effective administration. Mild anxiety, irritation and apprehension are part of administration. All these leave a consolidative positive influence on various domains of childhood development. Social development brings in the ability to forget and forgive mutual shortcomings. Children begin to perceive that for success, mutual goals are more important than mutual differences.

Boosts self-esteem

Successful participation and mass appreciation boosts children's self-esteem. Resolution of conflicts effectuates social harmony. Successful interaction with peers and adults further re-enforces their self-esteem and boosts their self-confidence.

Gives identity

Do not give up native traditions; they give children their identity. Cultural exposure

enhances knowledge of their cultural roots. Healthy bondage to the cultural beliefs of the family and the society works as an anchor for their social and emotional health.

Several things attract their attention during formative years. Festival celebrations, time and again make children live through temptations. Consequently they learn to modulate their desires through self-regulation.

Time tried, social and cognitive stimulation from festival celebrations, is, any day, better than modern interventional technology for normal child social development.

Excitement and happiness lasts for several days after the event

Boosted self-esteem, social popularity, healthy identity and resolved conflicts leave children positively motivated. Having experienced social impact with the family members, children do not frequently drift away from the family in pursuit of social experiences.
