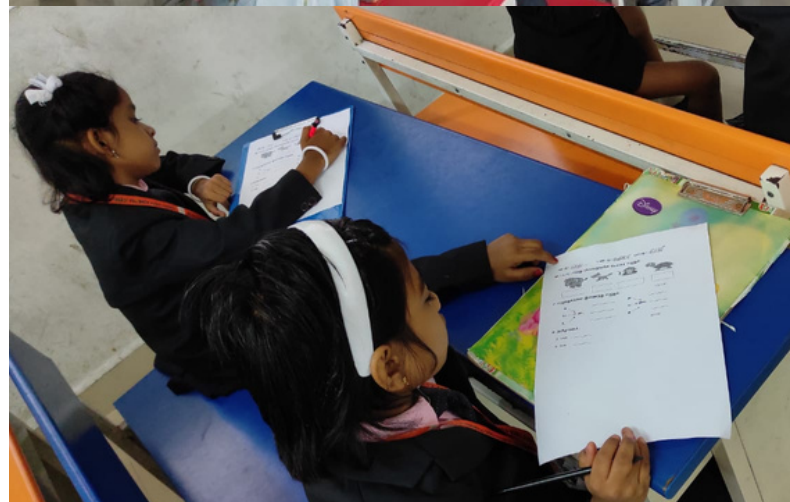




AN OFFICIAL VISIT
