This product is based on the Multiple Learning Experiences (M-LEXTM) Model, aims to make the teaching-learning process more experiential and enquiry-oriented. The M-LEXTM model has been developed on the following premises:

- Learning has multiple dimensions: understanding, application, critical thinking, creativity and communication.
- The teaching-learning process should include multisensory experiences (visual, auditory, verbal and kinaesthetic) to enable students to experience learning across different modalities.
- In order to enable students to participate actively in learning, meaningful multisensory activities need to be designed to promote each dimension of learning.

The intention of this framework is to enable teachers to resist fixed patterns of teaching, build on the natural curiosity of children, and convert the classroom into an active learning space (as opposed to passive transfer of information). This product provide multiple experiences to children and trigger their curiosity and in turn makes the student engage, explore and participate.

Studies show that the human brain has evolved to develop, learn and operate optimally in multisensory environments. So, when more senses are involved in learning, the better it is for retention. Therefore, each teaching point within a lesson contains multisensory activities that are well-aligned to the content. The activities are a combination of not just different auditory, modalities (visual. verbal. kinaesthetic) and levels of difficulty but are also a blend of discovery and practice activities. The M-LExTM model also makes use interdisciplinary correlations, which link one subject to another or to contemporary events and research. This model provides us with 3Dmodels, black board usage, storage and sharing of contents and easy accessibility. This product is beneficial, productive and make us to take a step ahead in the usage of technology(ICT) in the education.



Traditional seeds are typically open-pollinated and non-genetically modified (non-GMO). They are not usually hybrids, which means that the seeds can be saved and replanted without losing their characteristic traits. Traditional seeds are often known for their high nutrient content.

The concept of green revolution drastically shifted the focus of agriculture away from biodiversity to high-yielding crops. This has resulted in the reduction of the genetic base of traditional seed varieties that are now on the verge of extinction.
