SAFAL EXAM TRAINING WORKSHOP: EMPOWERING EDUCATORS FOR STUDENT SUCCESS

The CBSE facilitated a workshop on April 6th for the IT nodals of numerous CBSE-affiliated schools in the vicinity of Chennai, held at Chinmaya Vidyalaya, Anna Nagar. The seminar covered SAFAL, which stands for Structured Assessment for Analyzing Learning, a competency-based assessment designed for students in grades 5 and 8. Educators from JVK were in attendance at this event. The Central Board of Secondary Education introduced SAFAL in accordance with the National Education Policy 2020, which recommends shifting from rote memorization to competency-based learning. SAFAL assesses core concepts, application of knowledge, and higher order thinking skills. It provides schools with diagnostic information



about students learning to support competency-based education. SAFAL uses scaled scores with proficiency levels to offer detailed information to educators, helping identify what competencies a student has mastered and where they can improve. In phase one, the assessment will be conducted in about 20,000 schools across the country. The following are the key points discussed at the conference:

- *CBSE randomly selects students and batches for the pilot exam.
- *This exam focuses on core subjects such as Language, Science, and Mathematics.
- *The SAFAL exam is scheduled to take place in July 2024 .
- *It is an online exam which will be conducted in batches
- *Roll no exam ID will be provided by CBSE.
- *In this SAFAL pilot, candidates will be divided into batches (Maximum 3 batches per day). For each grade per subject, 2 days are allocated, so a maximum of 6 batches can be generated/accommodated.
- * No transcript or certificate of passing will be issued to students following this examination.
- *The pattern of questions will be MCQ (Multiple choice questions).
- *The syllabus for all subjects and classes will align with the school curriculum. There is no requirement for additional preparation specifically for the exam. A comprehensive evaluation report will be furnished to the school.
- * The school's assessment will be based on its students' performance.
- *Software requirements were discussed.

It was a brainstorming session that provided a comprehensive understanding of the SAFAL exam.

ENHANCING PEDAGOGICAL PROFICIENCY: MICROTEACHING AT JVK

JVK structured Microteaching, a teacher training technique, for its facilitators in April. Which provided the opportunity to perk up their teaching skills. With the demonstrated effectiveness among the novice and seniors, microteaching helps to promote real-time teaching expertise. The core skills of microteaching such as presentation and reinforcement skills helped the educators to improvise the skills of teaching. Participants demonstrated creativity and innovation in lesson planning, incorporating varied instructional strategies to engage learners effectively.

Effective use of visual aids, questioning techniques, and interactive activities enhanced participation and comprehension.

Each participant took turns delivering a brief instructional segment, typically lasting 5-10 minutes, while the rest of the group assumed the role of students.

Following each teaching round, Mrs.Nagalakshmi, Vice Principal of academics provided



constructive feedback to the presenter, highlighting strengths and areas for improvement. She also offered guidance and suggestions for enhancing teaching effectiveness. Areas identified for improvement included pacing, clarity of instructions, and classroom management techniques.

The microteaching session demonstrated significant value as a learning opportunity, enabling participants to refine their teaching skills and gain valuable insights into effective instructional practices. By providing a platform for focused practice, feedback, and reflection, microteaching functions as a crucial instrument for ongoing professional growth in the realm of education. JVK is committed to providing its students with the highest quality education possible.
