1. Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs): Testing students' ability to recognize correct grammar and sentence structure.

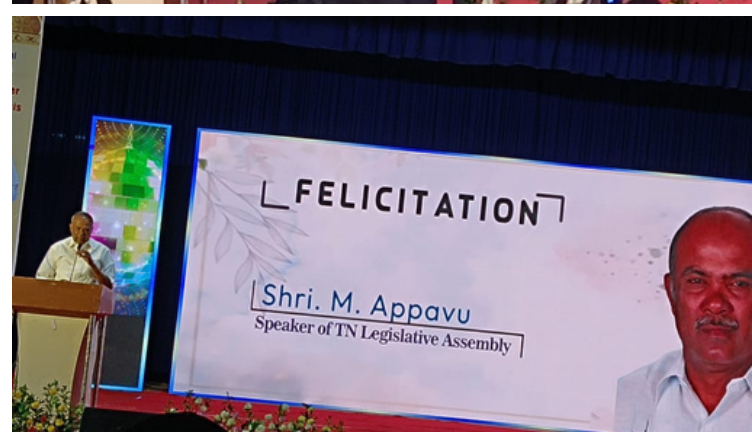
