Pongal is not just a harvest festival, but a time to appreciate the fruits of our labor, our friendships, and the joy of education.



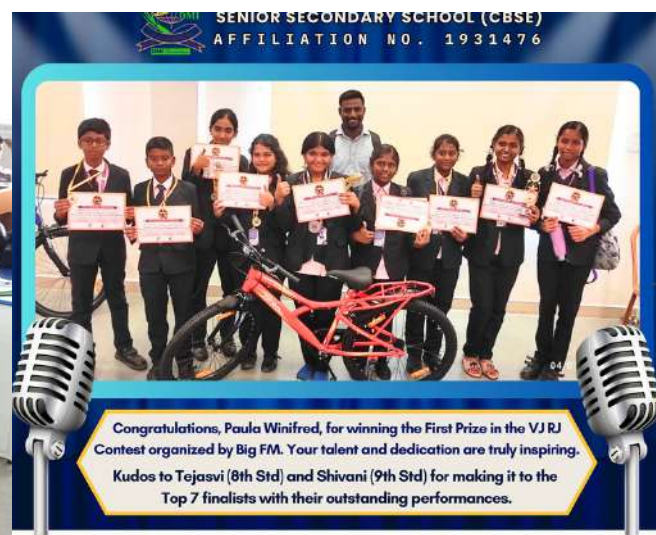
PERIODIC ASSESSMENT 4 : A COMPREHENSIVE EVALUATION FOR STUDENTS
